I have included a picture of a Dendrobium griffithianum that bloomed just two days after the last meeting. This plant hadn't bloomed for me before after quite a few years of ownership so I was particularly excited to see it spike rather vigorously. It is on a screened southern window with some light coming in from another window on with a western exposure. It gets soaked once a week, and then splashed generously with water twice more during the week. I have given it a fairly dry resting period over the winter.
